The minutes:

1. Prof Mosad started by greetings of all the attendees and clarify that the main purpose of the meeting is to discuss partners comments and recommendations regarding the wp1 survey report.
2. Prof Hoda Makhlof has been assigned to take notes to write the minute of the meeting.
3. Then Prof Ahmad Makhlof presented the two wp1 survey reports : one for stake holders and the other for senior student. Each report included analysis of results, conclusion and recommendations.
- 4- After the presentation , A discussion was carried out about the number of responders especially stakeholders (Total number shared in the survey of Senior health profession student survey was 73, while Total number shared in the survey of
- Stakeholder survey analysis was 27). A discussion was made about possible extension of the survey to allow partners to increase its number. However going through the trends of the results, it was clear that adding numbers would not change



the conclusions based on analysis of the results. So all agreed that there is no need to extend the survey.

- 5- The next discussion was about the framework of the surveys report. Dr Bassem recommended to revise the report by adding sections for introduction, aim of the survey and methodology and to revise the English editing and correct typing mistakes. Dr Rami recommended to align the report with the main objective of the whole project.
- 6- Professor Mosaad assigned WP1 plus professor Hoda Makhoulf and professor Bassem.
- 7- Then Prof Ahmad Makhoulf and Prof Moaad discussed the main recommendations of the survey starting by the need to develop guidelines for curriculum development including teaching and learning methods and assessment with involvement of students and stakeholders, for undergraduate and internship programs referring to international benchmarks and national standards and recent publications about competency based programs. Professor Mosaad requested all partners to share their programs for internship. To endorse the development of these guidelines.
- 8- There was agreement to issue the first draft of the guideline within 3 weeks and the final one within 3 months.
- 9- Prof Moaad recommended to add more members to the WP1 namely professor Hoda, Bassem and ...
- 10- Prof Ahmad recommended to develop 2 diplomas which will help in sustainability of the project:
 - Professional competency development
 - TOT of family medicine teaching
 - Biomedical technology (including biomedical engineering and bioinformatics)
 - Other recommendation was to develop short courses 6 ECTS (fulltime 1 week or part time 1 month)
- 11- Prof Mosaad advised to have observation in primary health care clinic (visits between Universities).
- 12- He also recommended that there is a need to run the I Care clinic as soon as possible.
- 13- The meeting participants agreed that the discussion of platform needs another meeting.
